Serve Your Audience

- People come to your site with questions in mind:
 - How do I join as an individual? As a club?
 - Where can I swim?
 - Are there any upcoming events?
 - Can I find results of an event I participated in?

Site Navigation

- Have a navigation scheme don't leave people stranded on a page inside your site
- Stick to your scheme be consistent on all pages
- Don't overwhelm with excessively large navigation elements or too many categories/choices
- Avoid main category titles that are too general such as 'info' or 'data'

Minimum Content

- Registration info online reg link &paper form, xfer form, club registration form
- Contacts list of officers
- Club lists with contact information, locations, workout info
- Calendar of events
- Event results
- Records

Design Standards

- Avoid background images or color schemes that reduce readability
- Don't use animated gif images or flashing text
- Avoid excessive use of colored text or multiple fonts
- Be aware that font color and underlining typically indicate a link on web pages – avoid using these for regular text
