Role overview and purpose, and how it relates to the organization's mission

Nominations to this committee are made by the USMS Board of Directors with approval by the USMS House of Delegates. The nominations are then forwarded to the USAS Board for consideration. If approved the nominations are forwarded to UANA for appointment to a 4 year term.

### Key responsibilities

- To represent all masters aquatic disciplines.
- Overseeing and approval of masters rules for all of the aquatic disciplines
- Awarding of Masters Pan American Championships, and the conduct of Masters Pan American championships.
- Members present at a Masters Pan American Championship comprise the Protest Committee for that championship in cooperation/coordination with the event director.
- The Masters Technical Committee meets at all Masters Pan American Championships, which is every two years and as needed between championships.
