As a member organization of USAS, USMS has representation on the USAS Aquatics Coordinating Board and one elected officer. USMS members may also fill other positions within USAS. The president serves as the USMS representative on the USAS Aquatics Coordinating Board. And, the Board appoints a member to serve as an officer of USAS. The elected officers of USAS are a President, two Vice Presidents, Secretary, and Treasurer, one from each of the 5 aquatic NGB's. Officers are elected by the Board of Trustees (members of all USAS member Boards) at the annual meetings held in even numbered years

Key responsibilities

- Historically and currently, the USMS officer has held the position of Treasurer, however this is not required.
- The Treasurer shall be the chief financial officer of the Corporation. As a member of the Finance Committee the treasurer prepares budgets, seek for and consider new sources of revenue, and oversee the investments of the Corporation. The Treasurer, with the assistance of the Finance Committee, prepares annual financial reports.
- Duties for other officer positions can be found in the United States Aquatic Sports, Inc. Code of Regulations.

- Historically the officers of USAS have previously been the president of the NGB. While this is not required, it is a preferred experience.
- Specific experience as a non-profit Treasurer is a plus.
