MINUTES:

The meeting was called to order at 7:02pm EDT.

APPROVAL OF THE LAST MEETING'S MINUTES

Motion by Cheryl Kupan to approve, 2nd by Sheila Carpenter-van Dijk. All voted in favor, none opposed, no discussion. **Motion passes**.

FINANCE REPORT – NANCY KRYKA

There are 2 changes to the budget that I sent to you prior to the meeting:

- 1) \$200 expense for Zoom for the annual "virtual" meeting
- 2) Unified Fee amounts to the LMSC need to be updated: from \$8 per swimmer to \$12 and for Clubs from \$11 to \$12.

This should result in a \$9,000 increase in revenues for 2020. Motion by Cheryl Kupan to approve the 2021 budget, 2nd by Jim Matysek. All voted in favor, none opposed, no discussion. **Motion passes.** Post meeting, Nancy provided the updated, approved budget (see attachment)

CHAIR REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP COORDINATOR REPORT – MEREDITH MOORE

As many of you know, I will be stepping down as the Membership Coordinator after 15 years with the FL LMSC. I have enjoyed it and will help train whoever will be the new Membership Coordinator.

Nov. 2019-Oct. 2020: 2,118 registered swimmers = 1,569 renewing + 187 non-renewing# + 362 new members #: Non renewing meaning they were returning swimmers, but were not registered with USMS during

Nov. 2018-Oct. 2019: 2,374 registered swimmers Ψ 9% for obvious reasons

Females were 47% of the membership, while Males were 53%.

253 swimmers took advantage of the late registrations which usually begin in July, started in May this year. USMS offered a special rate to non-renewing/non-registered swimmers a special \$60 rate (savings of \$45) that would be good until Dec. 2021.

2020: 64 registered clubs vs. 2019: 74 registered clubs

2021 registration for Clubs was open on October 1, 2020 and there are only 18 clubs who signed up so far. Please remember to register before individual 2021 registrations open on November 1, 2020. Please refer to the full report for more details.

SANCTIONS & TOP TEN – ANNA LEA MATYSEK & JIM MATYSEK

1) **Top Ten**: USMS decided they are going to publish a 2020 Long Course Meters Top Ten as there were two LCM meets this year. The Goodlife Games in Clearwater in February and there was an IGLA meet in Australia that USMS members swam in.

It is my understanding they will also be publishing a short course meters top ten. Sarasota Sharks plan on doing a SCM meet, but only for the team.

2) **Sanctions:** USMS has recently issued guidelines (not requirements) on how to run a meet.

Limit the size of the meet to 50 per session. Suggests on where everyone stands, 1 timer per lane if there isn't electronic timing, swimmers for the next heat will have to stand a safe distance from the timers, etc... Everyone will be required to sign a Covid release form asking all the typical questions (have you had a fever, been around someone who has tested positive, etc..) that the meet director saves for 90 days. In trying to avoid people traveling, there's a 100 mile travel restriction so people aren't hopping on planes to get to a meet. Please refer to the full report for more details.

SENIOR GAMES LIAISON - MIKE WHALEY

We were speaking earlier about the FL Senior Games in Dec. 2020 and still scheduled to take place in Cocoa Beach, FL. The FL Sports Commission has made arrangements for discounts with hotels in the area; 3 hotels are very close to the pool (Hilton is 5 minutes, Marriott is 8 minutes and Hyatt is 10 minutes).

No changes for the National Sr Games that are still scheduled for Nov. 2021 and the FL State Sr Games are still scheduled for July 2022.

Qualifying: those who qualified for New Mexico last year will qualify for Ft. Lauderdale next year. For full details, please see the report attached.

COACHES - SCOTT BAY

Everything was cancelled.

In terms of certification, there is a task force working on revamping the process. Not sure if you knew, but we had an online Level 1 Certification class and felt the in person learning was more effective. So, we hope to get back to in person training as soon as we can. All other coaching clinics are gone for the rest of 2020. Please refer to the full report attached.

2020 Annual Report From your FL LMSC Membership Coordinator, Meredith Moore

As of October 11, 2020, we have 2118 swimmers registered in the FL LMSC for 2020. (November 1, 2019 - October 11, 2020)

We are about 9% behind last years final October 2019 figure of 2374.

*1,569 were RENEWING members registered in 2019 (74%)

*187 were RETURNING members registered anytime between 1999-2018 (9%)

*362 were brand NEW members (17%)

53% are male, 47% are female. Almost all registrations were done online.

This year, Late Season Registrations started in late May instead of July. In response to COVID-19, USMS offered the rest of this year and all of 2021 for the single year price of \$60. A savings of over \$45. So far, the FL LMSC has had 253 registrations (May 26 - Oct 11) from the date they registered thru the end of 2021.

We had 64 Clubs registered in 2020; 74 Clubs in 2019.

2021 swimmer registration begins on November 1st. Clubs must be registered in order for swimmers to register for a particular Club. We have around 47 Clubs that still need to register for 2021. Also, a Parent Club must register before any Workout Group can register with a parent Club.

I want to thank all our Board Members, the FL LMSC, our Club Reps and all our swimmers for their encouragement and support!!! Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, USMS is waiving sanction fees for meets (\$50) and open water events (\$100) (including the open water insurance surcharge, up to \$900 depending on number of entrants) for the remainder of 2020. Recognition fees (\$100) will still be charged.

Senior Games Liaison Report Mike Whaley October 2020

2020 Florida Senior Games

- Florida Senior Games (FSG) is opening its Games for all participants to compete at its 2020 competition set for December 5-13, eliminating the requirement of competing at and finishing in the Top 5 of an individual's respective age group at one of its local series qualifiers.
- Anyone aged 50 and above can register for the 2020 Florida Senior Games without a qualifying performance, in previous years, a Top 5 finish, in the athlete's respective age division was required.
- The 29th Annual Florida Senior Games will be held December 5-13, for athletes age 50 and over.
- Individual event registration will open in the near future as facilities and competition dates are finalized.
- Participants are encouraged to check the FloridaSeniorGames.com website regularly for updated event information, locations, and registration.
- The Florida Sports Foundation Events Manager confirmed the 2020 Florida Senior Games Swim Meet on Saturday and Sunday, December 5 & 6, at Cocoa Beach Aquatic Center, 4800 Tom Warriner Blvd, Cocoa Beach, FL 32931. Registration deadline is November 2, 2020.

2021 National Senior Games

- While many State Games were unfortunately unable to conduct events this year, there are still 2020 Qualifying Games that are currently scheduled to happen in the next three months. Some can only host limited events, and conditions may change, please refer to the Florida State Games Information page for state contacts/websites and for the most up-to-date calendar.
- As a result of the shutdowns, NSGA established an Adjusted Qualification Process for the 2021 National Senior Games, coming to sunny Greater Fort Lauderdale in 2021. The information can be accessed on the How To Qualify page of NSGA website. NSGA will send notices to all qualified athletes later this year.

ADJUSTED QUALIFICATION:

- If a state qualifying senior games is able to conduct Games or specific sports/events in 2020, the qualification standards for the sports/events as specified in the 2021 NSGA Rulebook will determine qualifiers. In addition, athletes from that state's senior games who qualified for the 2019 National Senior Games in Albuquerque, NM will also qualify in the respective sports/events for the National Senior Games in 2021 (i.e., qualifiers from 2018 respective sports/events from that state's senior games).
- If a state qualifying senior games is unable to conduct Games or specific sports/events in 2020, athletes from that state's senior games who qualified for the 2017 National Senior Games in Birmingham, AL and/or 2019 National Senior Games in Albuquerque, NM will qualify in the respective sports/events for the 2021 National Senior Games (i.e., qualifiers from 2016 and/or 2018 respective sports/events from that state's senior games).

2022 State Games of America

- The State Games of America is an Olympic-style event featuring competition between State Games medal winners (gold, silver, bronze) from across the nation. There are currently 30 states conducting or organizing statewide sports festivals known as State Games. The State Games of America is an event of the National Congress of State Games.
- The Iowa Games, in collaboration with, Iowa State University, Ames Convention and Visitors Bureau and Catch Des Moines announced that the 2021 State Games of America will be moved to 2022. The rescheduling of the event comes in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, which caused many state games to cancel or modify their games this summer. The 2022 State Games of America will be held July 27-31.
- Qualifying requirements for Non-Iowa Residents:
 - 2019 (after July 1): All gold, silver and bronze medalists qualify from National Congress of State Games (NCSG) Member State programs, both Winter and Summer.
 - 2020: All athletes who participated in an NCSG Member State event, both Winter and Summer, qualify.
 - 2021: All gold, silver, and bronze medalists qualify from NCSG Member State programs, both Winter and Summer.
 - 2022 (before July 1): All gold, silver, and bronze medalists qualify from NCSG Member State programs, both Winter and Summer.
 - Any medalists from the 2019 State Games of America are eligible to compete in 2022 if they participate in a NCSG Summer or Winter Games event in their state between July 1, 2019 July 1, 2022.
- The National Congress of State Games will be hosting its first State Games of America Virtual Games starting September 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. The sporting events featured are cycling, disc golf, duathlon, figure skating, fishing, footgolf, golf, rowing, running, swimming and taekwondo. Athletes regardless of age or ability level are eligible to participate in the Virtual Games. Registered athletes will receive a medal and a t-shirt for each event in which they are registered. Participants' results and finishing photos/videos are submitted to the State Games of America website where participants will be featured on a virtual leaderboard. Each sporting event costs \$30 except for figure skating which is \$50.
- The State Games of America Virtual Games provide a safe, grassroots opportunity for athletes of all ages and abilities to compete in the sports they love and qualify for the 2022 State Games of America. All participants competing in the State Games of America Virtual Games (except for those registered for swimming & figure skating) will qualify for the 2022 State Games of America – in the sport in which they competed. The 2022 State Games of America will be held in Ames / Des Moines, Iowa.
- According to a FSF Event Manager, the FSF links results of the Florida Sunshine Games to the State Games of America but not the Florida Senior Games.
