In 2014- the USMS National membership system in-sourced from Club Assistant to "in house, USMS Membership system"

Sanctions - Sally Guthrie

This year MI Masters sanctions meets in all courses – SCY SCM and LCM. Sally will be making up a meet schedule for fall and winter within the next couple of weeks. If anyone has any questions on sanctioning a meet, and sanction fees – please contact Sally and/or Patrick Weiss.

Communications- Sally Guthrie

Sally thanked all for their help with the website and with the newsletter. Newsletter goes out twice a year.

Skip informed the assembly that Sally won the USMS Communications award given at the Convention.

Skip recognized those who made Top 10 and all who broke MI Masters records.

Open Water- Gail Dummer spoke of the reason why the insurance is for an open water event is so high and because of this – MI Masters is not sanctioning any open water events this year.

Fitness – no report Officials - no report

Gail recognized that Sue Berger-Mann and Don Swalwell both received the Kerry O'Brien coach of the year award.

Coaching – Rachel Cush

Rachel will make up relays for Nationals and World Championships. Skip asked who was going to pay for the relays? Skip informed the assembled members that there are no deck entries for Canadian Nationals or World Championships. Should be a system in place. Patrick Weiss stated that the entry fee for relays at Nat's and World's are expensive and we want to only enter relays that are definitely going to swim. Several members offered to help with relays.

Rachel also stated she is hoping to put on a coaching clinic in the fall.

Safety – no report

2. 2015 State Meet

Skip was the only one to bid – 2015 State meet will be held at Eastern University the 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} week in April.

Other items for discussion:

- a) Scholarship fund should we continue this or use up the funds and then discontinue. At this point the majority of the members would like this to continue and expand to helping people with the registration fee if they are unable to afford it.
- b) Should we continue with the awards given at the State Meet or should they be given at the Awards Banquet?

There was some discussion about this and at this time these awards should be separated as they are given for different purposes and attract different people.

c) Should the high point award continue – and should the award be a plaque or something else.

One year the high point award was a towel – some loved it – some didn't. Some love the plaque and are proud of it – some don't care.

It was pointed out that the high point award does motivate some people to come and swim 7 events – even if it means swimming an event they don't normally swim.

d) Should the annual meeting be tied into the State Meet or held at a different time? Ralph Davis said that having the annual meeting at the state meet and offering lunch draws people to the meeting. If it were to be held at a different time, many people won't come.

The majority of the members would like the meeting to stay tied into the State Meet.

- e) Should MI Masters host a LC State Meet? Summer season is so short and don't see this happening.
- f) Merchandise for MI Masters.

Sue Berger-Mann would love to design a shirt/logo for MI Masters
Skip said we have a logo and shirts are given to those who represent MI at Nationals.
