Status	The MN LMSC US Bank balance of funds is \$66,177. MN LMSC also has 2 CDs at Bremer Bank. This puts our total assets at about \$73,702.

	Brian H. did not have a P&L for the Zone Meet but said it was close to break even.
	Nancy will determine if there is any advantage to move from Quicken to Quick Books.
