1.) Roll Call

2.) Adoption of Minutes – Douglas Sayles

• The minutes of the 2015 Annual Membership Meeting (as posted on the NE-LMSC website) were unanimously adopted after being moved and seconded.

3.) Adoption of Treasurer's Report – Al Prescott

- Total assets as of 12/31/15 are \$42,110 (including liabilities)
- o Total Revenue for 2015 was \$21,456
- Total Expenses for 2015 \$19,850
- Estimated income for 2016 is \$16,800
- Currently have \$48,660 in the NE-LMSC bank account.

- Action item: Follow up with USMS regarding mysterious \$226 USMS registration fee charge.
- Motion to approve LMSC banner purchase ("Other Office Supplies" in Budget sheet). After being seconded, the motion was approved unanimously.
- The attached Treasurer's report was unanimously adopted after being moved and seconded.

4.) Reports, as necessary, from Officers and Committees

• Registrar - Tim Lecrone

- NE-LMSC has 2502 members and 23 clubs as of 10/16/2017. Seven clubs are currently registered for the 2017.
- 56 workout groups are registered as of 10/16/17. 13 workout groups are registered for 2017.
- \circ Individual USMS registration/renewals for 2017 open on 11/1/2017.
- Tim is actively following up with club & WOG contacts re: renewing ASAP to minimize the confusion and extra work that results when USMS members cannot find their team affiliations in the USMS registration database while renewing their individual memberships for 2017.
- Action Item: Include registration reminders in LMSC e-newsletter

• Pool Sanctions Chair - Mindy Williams

- Mindy reported that USMS-sanctioned (i.e., USMS-insured) meets must use the USMS waiver verbatim, whereas recognized meets do not use the USMS waiver because recognized meets are not insured by USMS.
- At the USMS annual meeting in September, the House of Delegates voted to impose a \$100 USMS meet recognition fee. The \$50 USMS sanction fee remained unchanged. Currently, the NE LMSC fully subsidizes the USMS sanction fee so it is <u>not</u> passed on to meet hosts.
- Rick Osterberg made a multipart motion, as follows:
 - 1. The NE-LMSC will subsidize the USMS recognition fee to the level of the USMS sanction fee (currently \$50). If the USMS sanction fee changes, the NE-LMSC recognition subsidy will change accordingly.
 - 2. Hosts of USMS-sanctioned pool meets may offer one-event (OEVT) entries at the discretion of the meet host/director. (The NE LMSC previously only allowed OEVT registrations for sanctioned open-water events).
 - The NE LMSC <u>not</u> subsidize the USMS OEVT fee (currently \$15) for any sanctioned events, pool or open water. (The NE LMSC previously provided a \$2 OEVT registration subsidy for sanctioned open-water events).
- The objective of the above motion is to give meet hosts a financial incentive to run a sanctioned meet rather than a recognized meet, while setting the recognition fee at a level (currently \$50) that does not discourage USMS involvement altogether.

- Mindy moved to amend Rick's motion to remove the OEVT aspect of his proposal. Three in favor, motion failed. Amendment failed.
- Rick's original motion was seconded and approved as proposed.
- Action Item: Alana and Mindy to update the website to reflect the updated recognition and OEVT fees/policies.
- Guy stated that in 2016 approximately 900 NE-LMSC members swam in recognized meets, accounting for ~2100 splashes (Guy)
- Doug stated that, according to USMS, in 2015 there were 20 recognized meets and 10 sanctioned meets in the NE LMSC, accounting for 25 percent of all recognized meets nationwide. In the spring of 2016 USMS President Patty Miller inquired about the potential reasons for this disproportionate ratio relative to other LMSCs.

• Coaches Chair – Crystie McGrail

- The Karlyn Pipes coaches/swimmers clinic was a resounding success
- USMS Level 1 & 2 coaches training had ~30 NE-LMSC attendees and the USMS coaches/swimmers clinic held the next day at WPI was also well-attended
- Four coaches received NE-LMSC subsidizes to attend the National Coaches Clinic in San Francisco in November 2016. After they return from the national clinic, participating NE-LMSC coaches will contribute written pieces to the NE LMSC and run clinics open to all NE-LMSC members.
- o USMS Officials training will include an online option for certification

• Top Ten SCY Chair – Lazlo Eger (written report submitted in absentia)

- In 2016 we had 16 SCY, 5 SCM, and 2 LCM meets. Trend for total meets is decreasing.
- A total of 1,172 swimmers swam in SCY meets in 2016, of which 742 swimmers swam at the SCY Championship Meet at Harvard.
- Doug observed that the NE LMSC is trending toward having several smaller meets (10 to 70 swimmers) while aggregate meet attendance is slowly decreasing.

• Communications Chair/Webmaster – Alana Aubin

- Has been updating and maintaining the NE-LMSC website including all events and monthly LMSC emails.
- o Meet results, reports, and photos would be helpful for website and email updates
- Created group on "Slack" app for board members to communicate and work on various projects such as the NE-LMSC newsletter updates.

• Secretary – Ryan Kleinert

• Para-Athlete Chair – Laura Dennison

- Laura announced that the Boston Para Athlete Division has started and meets every Wednesday.
- Bay State Games had a para- athlete division.
- Attended Paralympic Trials
- Proposal: Para athlete division at SCY champs and SCM champs meets. This will allow para athletes to score and will help increase visibility and para athlete attendance. Rick: May not have current flexibility at the National level to implement a Para athlete division. Action Item: National Rules committee
- Proposal to invite and bring in director of U.S. Paralympic Swimming/para coaches/para athlete swimming for a training to educate about para swimming and hold a training for para athletes on an annual basis. Proposal to be further investigate/defined by Lara Crystie offered to help her structure proposal/budget.

• Open Water Chair – Charlotte Brynn

- Sanctioning fee is 100 plus a \$5 individual fee, \$15 one event registration fee,
- No longer requirement for an Independent safety monitor
- o 2016 had 4 open water events, 1 event an open water national championship
- Working with Alana to promote awareness and education about Open water swimming including profiling swimmers and their open water accomplishments

• Vice Chair- Guy Davis

• Officials Chair – Sue Jensen

- Had about four inquiries from meet directors asking for assistance to find officials for meets
- o USMS announced an official certification program
- New England has many active officials (~30 active)
- Awards and Recognition Chair Tara Mack
 - Tara presented Coach of the Year Award to Alford Green and Contributor of the Year Award to Douglas Sayles
 - Tara is interested in looking into USMS swag items
- c
- USMS put \$600,000 in "reserve" to develop miscellaneou programs and initiatives including a new fitness program, website development, open water meet result database development, funding college club development to encourage USMS swimming post college.

- Educational focus on Coaches certification/training, Adults Learn to Swim (ALTS) instructor certification, Swimmer stroke clinics.
- USMS registration fees will increase by \$2 for 2017 registration ear
- Club and workout group registration fee will be same as individual fee \$40.
- Open water sanction and insurance fees continue to decrease, but a meet recognition fee of \$100 dollars was approved by HOD -- meet recognition is being discouraged and instead meet sanctioning is being pushed by USMS).
- Awards and Recognition Chair Tara Mack
 - Dates of 2017 NE-LMSC SCY Championship Meet at Harvard: 3/11/, 3/17-3/19

5.) Unfinished Business

- Christina Dwiggins stepped down as Communications Chair and Alana Aubin who was already the NE-LMSC webmaster stepped up as the Communications Chair.
- Doug made a motion to ratify Alana's appointment as communications chair. After being seconded, the motion was approved unanimously.

E.) New Business

A. LMSC fees and subsidies

- Currently charge \$7 for NE-LMSC registration fee.
- Al Motions to set LMSC fee at \$5 dollars per member, Alana seconds and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Currently have a \$2 subsidiary for one event registration fee for open water events.
 Chrystie motions to remove \$2 subsidiary, Guy seconds and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Doug suggests developing a Task force to address supporting open water swimming in the NE-LMSC

B. Potential edits to Bylaws

 Bylaws last updated at 2015 annual meeting. Bylaws discussion tabled for potential future review, potentially by a board task force to determine if any proposed changes are warranted.

C. New USMS LMSC Standards

 New LMSC standards approved by USMS Board of Directors. New USMS operating guidelines. Doug, Al, and Guy to report on NELMSC's compliance and any needed changes.

D. Discussion – USMSC/LMSC Structure

- There is some duplication of member services between NEM Swim Club and the NELMS. There is the potential for expansion of the NE-LMSC newsletter and/or website.D oug suggests continuing to look at what the LMSC can do to increase value to the NE-LMSC membership and eliminate NEM crossover.
- At USMS convention, Doug suggested to USMS CEO and board members to dissolve zones and hire regional managers to handle administrative functions so that LMSC board members can focus more on creating/providing membership value.
- Bill suggests swimmers being allowed to swim on relays within their NE-LMSC at National and International meets. Currently no mechanism in FINA/USMS to allow swimmers from different clubs to do so.

E. Discussion – Using LMSC savings to add value to membership

- Explored ways to add value to the LMSC SCY championship meet.
- Discussed creation of NELMSC Championship subcommittee.

F. Proposal

 Tim made a motion for the NELMSC to propose to the USMS Rules Committee that 25 yard/meter events become recognized, sanctioned, and entered in databases. Al seconds. 10 in favor 6 against. 3 abstained. Motion passes. Tim to draft proposal.

G. Awards & Recognition

 Tara presented the 2016 Contributor of the Year Award to Douglas Sayles and the 2016 Coach of the Year Award to Alford Green

6.) Resolutions and Orders

- Coach certification support increased to \$4,000.
- Development fund decreased to \$5,000. And redistributed to other line items.
- Para-Athlete/Coaches training \$2,000
- \circ $\;$ Long course mini-meet subsidiaries line items renamed Championship Meet Support $\;$
- The 2017 budget was proposed. The budget was moved, seconded, and approved (see attached).
