## **Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m.

MSA to amend R 56 to switch the order of words to read: "B. (1) If two of the three button times or two of the three watch times agree, the time of the two buttons or two watches in agreement shall be the time for that timing system.

## 103.8.5 Start Commands

C On the starter's command "Take your mark," the <u>each</u> swimmer shall immediately assume a starting position with at least one that maintains at least one foot at the front of the starting platform, or at the edge front of the pool <u>deck</u> or on the wall. Swimmers may not adjust the front foot position forward following the "take your mark" command. A swimmer starting in the water must have at least one foot on the wall and at least one hand in contact with the wall or starting platform. When all swimmers are stationary, the starter shall give the starting signal.

**101.1.1 Forward Start**—The forward start may be taken from the starting block, the pool deck or a push from the wall. At the commencement of each heat, the referee shall signal to the swimmers by a short series of whistles to remove all clothing except for swimwear, followed by a long whistle indicating that they should take their positions with at least one foot at the front of the starting platform or the edge of pool deck or on the wall before the command "Take your mark.". Those Swimmers starting in the water should take their positions on the wall with must have at least one hand in contact with the wall or starting block platform and one foot in contact with the wall before the command "Take your mark".

Since this rule may still lack clarity, it was recommended by the Committee that an official interpretation be published by the USMS Rules Chairman.
