Minutes

The Chair, Kathy Casey, called to order an email meeting of the Rules Committee on 9/6/12.

- 1. The Chairman had previously sent a copy of the 2012 rules proposals to the Rules Committee members for their consideration and a ballot of their opinions. After the preconvention ballot, the Chairman grouped the rules proposals into three groups for consideration. These groups were: <u>Group One</u> those proposals that committee members unanimously thought should be recommended, <u>Group Two</u> those proposals that were one vote short of a unanimous recommendation, and <u>Group Three</u> those that were two or more votes short of unanimity.
- 2. The <u>Group One</u> proposals that had unanimous support by committee members were: R 8, R 31, R 52, R 58, R 60, R 69, R 87, HK 1, HK 2, HK 6, HK 9, HK 12, HK 13, HK 14, and HK 15. <u>Group Two</u> proposals that were one vote short of unanimous were: R 21, R 24, R 27, R 33, R 35, R 39, R 41, R 47, R 56, R 66, R 76, R 77, R 80, R 83, R 89, R 90, R 91,HK 4, HK 5, HK 10, HK 11, and HK 16. <u>Group Three</u> proposals that were two or more votes short of unanimity were R 18, R 23, R 26, R 29, R 42, R 44, R 63, R 71, R 72, R 92, R 93, HK 7, and HK 8.
- 3. Leianne Crittenden moved and Matt Hooper seconded to approve the Group One proposals to be recommended to the HOD.
