Therefore, those individuals will pay \$25.00 as a one-time event participant plus the local event fee.

 - Currently SD's LMSC has over 100 members. Encourage local club members to participate in postal swim offerings – it's a great way to build a club.

 - Jenny Hodges noted that local groups can register as an official LMSC workout group – let Jenny know. The LMSC will pay the \$45.00 fee to USMS so the group can be recognized (also part of the Gold Star Club criteria).
