



USMS Coaches at ASCA World Clinic Grant Application Form

The American Swim Coaches Association is hosting its 2008 World Clinic at the Riviera Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas from September 3-7, 2008. Along with many other outstanding tracks, the Masters track is being held on Friday, September 5th, featuring Susan Ingraham of Texas and Conrad Johnson of Team New York Aquatics. Additionally, an informative open form focusing on Masters coaching is slated for Saturday. The Speakers Track, Open Forum, and the Clinic is a tremendous opportunity for current coaches to enhance their knowledge of Masters coaching and attend various other lectures by the world's best coaches and researchers.

To enhance participation, and to promote Masters Coaches attending the ASCA Clinic, USMS will pay \$150 toward the ASCA member World Clinic fee. A limited number of Masters coaches will receive this grant. These grants will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis and to no more than three coaches in one LMSC. Registration forms are due to Mel Goldstein by May 15, 2008.
