## Meet Statistics -

While everyone is anxiously awaiting psych sheets, heat sheets and decisions on how the meet will be run here are some anecdotal statistics about the meet sign-ups:

There are 1107 swimmers entered in the meet.

221 clubs will be represented.

The average age for the meet is 47.3.

Oldest male swimmer is 90 and the oldest female swimmer is 96 years old.

There are 428 women and 679 men in the meet.

The average number of events per swimmer is 4.2.

114 swimmers purchased gold sponsorships for the meet and will be given VIP access to hospitality.

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest Long Course National Championship Meet in 10 years and 4<sup>th</sup> overall. Having a 5 day format will help keep the days shorter.

81% of the entries were received on-line. And, 13% were submitted the last 4 days!

Largest team has 99 swimmers entered in the meet,  $2^{nd}$  largest has 63, third largest has 58 and fourth largest has 47 swimmers.

There are 65 teams with only one swimmer attending.

Coincidentally, there are also 65 unattached swimmers.

<u>Sixth Event</u> - The sixth event will be determined very soon. All swimmers who entered six events for this meet <u>may</u> have their designated sixth event removed from their entry.

<u>Estimate Time-line</u> - The <u>estimated</u> timeline for the meet will be posted in PDF format at <a href="http://www.usms.org/comp/lcnats05/">http://www.usms.org/comp/lcnats05/</a>. The Time Line is **ONLY** a guide to swimmers for use in determining the start of all events. It is the responsibility of all entrants to get to the pool for their event. It is prudent to give yourself about an hour of padding. It is normal and expected to have deviations in the timeline.

<u>Relays</u> - A relay may be entered until 4:00 PM the day before it is scheduled to be swum. Each relay costs \$12. Relay entries may be submitted to the meet host prior to the meet or at the relay desk in the registration area up until the close time for that specific relay. All relay members must have entered the meet and paid the individual or relay surcharge by the individual meet entry deadline. No deck entries, even for relay only swimmers.

Each swimmer must be a registered Masters swimmer. Each of the four members of any relay team must be properly registered with the same Masters club. Unattached swimmers may not swim on relay teams. Relay entry is in addition to individual events. A swimmer may swim each relay event only once (limit of 4 relay events per swimmer).

Customary massage fees are \$10 per 10 min. Actual prices may vary.
