USMS is always interested in having potential bidders submit an application and prepare a bid packet to the Championship Committee and later upon acceptance a presentation to the USMS House of Delegates our annual convention in September.

You will need the following:

1. Application for a USMS National Championship
2. Financial Report Summaries
3. Sample Budget
4. Sample Meet Contract
6. Pool Length Certification Form

The above information should assist you in making a decision to bid. Short Course Nationals may be held between April 15 and May 31 and Long Course Nationals may be held between August 1 and September 15.

The complete bid application and all required attachments are due no later than August 1, 2009. The original bid packet should be sent to me, and a copy of the bid packet must be sent to each Championship Committee members.

Bids shall be reviewed at the United States Aquatic Sports Convention to be held September 16-20 in Chicago, IL, and if awarded a formal bid presentation would be made by you or your representative(s) to the House of Delegates.
