Instructions: Please enter the age group, A/B/C designation, and an achieved time or a reasonable aggregate time for your relay teams under the correct event column. **IF YOU ENTER "NO TIME" YOUR ENTRY WILL BE REJECTED.**

Entry Deadline: A relay may be entered until 3:00 PM the day before it is scheduled to be swum. Each relay costs \$12. Relay entries may be submitted prior to the meet or at the relay desk in the registration area. All relay swimmers must have entered the meet by March 27, 2014. Swimmers entering relays only and no individual events must complete the individual entry form, pay the surcharge, and sign the liability release.

Relay Eligibility: Each swimmer must be a registered Masters swimmer. Each of the four members of any relay team must be properly registered with the same Masters club. **Unattached swimmers may not swim on relay teams.** Relay entry is in addition to individual events. A swimmer may swim each relay event only once (limit of 4 relay events per swimmer).

Age Groups: Relay age groups are: 18+, 25+, 35+, 45+, etc. (10-year increments as high as necessary, determined by the age of the youngest relay member). Age for the meet is determined as of May 4, 2014. Designate A, B, C, etc. if you have more than one relay in the same age group.

Please Note: Relay cards will not be checked for mistakes and omissions made by team representatives.

Disqualifications resulting from mistakes and omissions shall not be reconsidered.

Accuracy and completeness are the responsibility of the coaches and/or swimmers submitting the forms.

If you know the names of the swimmers on your relays, you may submit the names now and they will be printed on the relay card generated by the computer. Supplying this information prior to the relay being seeded should assist you in organizing your swimmers and will expedite relay results after the event is swum.

You may still change the name at any time prior to the relay being swum by crossing out the name (s) on the card and replacing with the new names and age. No changes in the age group or seed time are allowed. Any change of swimmers must therefore keep the relay in the same age group or the relay will be disqualified.
