ELIGIBILITY All swimmers must hold current USA Swimming or USMS cards. Any swimmer entered who is

not registered will be subject to a \$50 fine. Swimmer's age group will be determined by his/her

age the first day of the meet.

ENTRIES

Swimmers may enter 3 individual events. Deck registration will not be provided. Events will be pre-seeded. If time permits, we will host a Fun Relay (format TBD) at the end of the meet. Sign up for the fun relay at the meet.

Times to be submitted SCY. No time (NT) is acceptable.

Entries into the 1650 will be limited to the first 18 entrants who will race in three (3) mixed gender heats. Please note that we are limiting each heat of the mile to 30 minutes. This means that in order to enter the 1650 your average pace time should be less than 2:00 per 100 yards.

This meet is limited to the first 100 registrants, but teams will not be split.

SCORING

This meet will not be scored.

AWARDS

Swimmers will receive a swim cap for their participation. Ribbons will be awarded through 20th place. Meet participants can also Stay & Play after the meet on Saturday for free. (One free admission ticket per participant for the Indoor Aquatic Center to be redeemed December 13, 2014). Non-participants who want to open swim after the meet may do so for \$5.00 (ages 12+), \$4.50 (ages 3-11), and \$1.50 (under age 2) each.

FUN RELAY

If time permits, we will host a Fun Relay (format TBD) at the end of the meet. Sign up for the fun relay at the meet.

CONDUCT

Current USA Swimming and USMS rules will apply.

Protests will be handled in the manner described in Section 102.11 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

Snake River Swimming, Inc. safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be followed. A copy of the guidelines will be included in the heat sheets and posted at the pool.

Use of audio or video recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Except when venue facilities require otherwise, changing in to or out of swim suits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.

202.3.2 – At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down.

103.2.2 Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

MISCELLANEOUS

Coaches should report all event scratches prior to the start of the meet.

Volunteer timers will be needed from participating teams.

Marshals and officials who are current members of USA Swimming to be provided by the participating teams.
