
Cascade Lakes Swim Series & Festival at Elk Lake Site Map & Safety Craft Coverage Plan



Safety Craft Coverage:

- 500-meter Time Trial (out-and-back course along a 250-meter cable): 6-8 spotters and 2 rescue craft, staggered equally on each side of the cable. We will use zone-style coverage for the duration of the race.
- 1000-meter Swim (along the west shoreline then back straight to the finish): 8-10 spotters and 2
 rescue craft on a 1000-meter loop. We will use accordion-style coverage (spotters and rescue craft
 move to fixed positions with the first wave of swimmers, hold position during the swim, and return
 with the final swimmers). Most craft will stay on the inside of the course for coverage, with 2 spotters
 outside the course at the farthest turns for additional coverage and directional control.
- 1500, 3000, & 5000-meter swims. 12-15 spotters and 2 rescue craft on a 1500-meter loop (2000-meter loop for the first loop of the 5000-meter swim). Accordion-style coverage. All spotter craft stay on the outside of the course for coverage and directional control (except as needed) and all rescue craft will stay on the inside of the course.
- Evacuation Points: The nearest shoreline.
