Team Entry information

A CLUB may nominate three or four members to compete in the team relay event (only the top three finishes will be used for scoring). The entry fee for the team relay event is \$5.00 per swimmer. To take part in team relay competition, a swimmer must also be entered in the individual event. A Mixed Relay Team may have no more than two male and two female swimmers. The top three Male Teams, Female Teams, and Mixed Gender Teams, will each receive awards. Scoring is based on overall placement, with lowest score winning. You must designate your relay teams, **by** 7:30 A.M. race day.

LOCATION

Estero Island, Florida (Fort Myers Beach)

COURSE

The course is a rectangular course, parallel to Estero Island. Swimmers will do four (4) circuits. Tide is minimal and water temperatures should be in the mid 70's.

RACE TIME

Check in:	7:00 A.M.
Final briefing:	7:40 A.M.
Race begins:	8:00 A.M.

ELIGIBILITY

The race is open to all swimmers currently registered with USMS. A copy of your 2005 USMS registration card MUST be included with the entry form. Foreign swimmers must present a letter of introduction from their national Masters organization.

ENTRY LIMIT

Swimmers may enter one individual and one team event only. A maximum of 400 swimmers (200 male and 200 female) may compete.

Awards will also be given to the top male/female overall finishers, to the top male/female over 50 finishers, and to designated members of the top three relay teams in Male, Female, and Mixed categories.
