Event: The USMS National 5-Mile Open Water Championship will be conducted according to the long distance swimming rules of United States Masters Swimming. Ocean water temperature in August is usually 68-72 degrees Fahrenheit.

Location: The race is held in the La Jolla Ecological Reserve, which is seaside of Kellogg Park in La Jolla, California. The course begins near the boat launching area on La Jolla Shores Beach and then follows the perimeter buoys of the La Jolla Ecological Reserve. The Start/Finish area is located south of the centrally located parking lot and Main Lifeguard Tower in Kellogg Park. Pets are not allowed in the park or on the beach.

Schedule: Event Check-In is Sunday morning 7:00-8:00 am. Swimmer escort briefing begins at 8:00 am with an expected escort launch time of 8:15 am. Swimmer briefing begins at 8:15 am. Starting time for swimmers will not be before 8:30 am. There is a 4-hour cutoff time for the race. Awards presentations will begin at 11:30 am.

Eligibility: The event is open to all USMS (or foreign equivalent) registered swimmers who are 18 years of age or older as of August 7, 2005. A photocopy of the swimmer's 2005 USMS or foreign equivalent card must be submitted with the entry form as proof of current registration. Swimmers' cannot obtain USMS registration at the event.

Entry Fees: The fee for entries received prior to July 16 is \$35; the late registration fee is \$50 for entries received by August 3. This fee includes tee shirts for both the competitor and escort. Day-of-race entries by USMS or foreign registered swimmers will be accepted for a \$70 fee, but tee shirts cannot be guaranteed for the swimmer and escort. Submission of a photocopy of the 2005 registration card is mandatory. The entry fee includes pre- and post-race food and drink for entered swimmers and escorts. **Incomplete forms will be returned to the applicant**.

Lodging: A list of locations and rates will be available on <u>www.lajollacoveswimclub.org</u>.

Rules: (1) Current USMS long distance swimming rules govern the event. (2) A USMS-legal swim suit, cap and goggles are all that can be worn at this event. **NO** wetsuits or flotation or propulsion aids are allowed. Any swimmer wearing a wetsuit will be disqualified and will be ineligible for awards or placings. (3) **Each participant must have and is responsible for a paddleboard or kayak escort.**

Volunteer Escorts: All swimmers are responsible for obtaining a kayak or paddleboard escort. Race organizers can assist you in finding a volunteer escort from the San Diego area on a "first come-first served" basis. If a volunteer escort is found, then you will be provided with the contact information. You are responsible for contacting the volunteer promptly, agreeing upon the relationship, and notifying the race organizers. If you do not contact the volunteer escort within 7 days, we may offer the escort to another applicant.

Safety: Lifeguards in motor craft and safety kayaks will monitor the entire course. The course is also monitored from the Main Lifeguard Tower at La Jolla Shores Beach.

Seeding: Race organizers may create wave starts, and faster swimmers may start later. Each applicant must submit an "expected per-mile pace over 5 miles (Minutes: Seconds per mile)" based on his or her swimming experience within the past year.

Post-Race Food: All swimmers and kayak escorts will receive free meal tickets at check-in. Other guests may purchase meal tickets on race day for \$5 per person.

Awards: USMS medals will be given to the first five swimmers in each USMS age group/gender category. A special plaque will be awarded to overall male and female winners. A USMS Championship patch will be awarded to each age group winner. Results will be posted approximately one week after the race on www.lajollacoveswimclub.org.

Directions: From the north take I-5 to Hwy 52 East; exit at Regents Rd and double back onto 52 West; stay in the left lanes which become La Jolla Pkwy. From the south take I-5 to La Jolla Pkwy. Continue West on La Jolla Pkwy; at the 3d traffic signal turn right on La Jolla Shores Drive. Drive about half a mile and turn left onto Calle Frescota. Drive SLOWLY through the neighborhood to the Kellogg Park parking lot. The Check-In site and Start/Finish are on the La Jolla Shores beach 200 yards south of the parking lot.
