

Please note that the USMS Championships will be swum in conjunction with the 14th Annual Death Valley Open Water Swim Meet. There will be other events in the water at the same time the Masters' National Championships will be swum.

- USMS 10K NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: The course will consist of a 5K loop marked every 100 meters with buoys. The swim will be two times around the course for a total of 10K. The race will end 2 hours after the first individual finishes. All swimmers who have not completed the course at that time will be asked to retire. Check-in: 7:00am; Prerace Meeting: 8:30am; Event start: ~8:45am.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all USMS registered athletes, with age determined the day of the race. A oneevent registration is available for non-USMS athletes 18 and over. This fee is \$12. One-event registered swimmers may not receive USMS All-American recognition.
- **ENTRY FEES:** \$30.00 includes one event, cap, t-shirt and athlete hospitality. Entry deadline is June 7, 2008. All entries received after that date require a \$5.00 late fee. Late fee applies to day-of-event entries. Those entering on race day or after June 7 may or may not receive a T-shirt (**THERE WILL BE NO REDUCTION IN FEE**).
- **RULES:** All applicable USMS rules, regulations and safety requirements will be enforced for the well-being of our swimmers.
- **SAFETY:** Safety boats, canoes, and kayaks will monitor the entire course, with water bottles available to athletes. Swimmers must wear race cap and numbers on both arms and back for identification. Medical personnel will be on site.
- **SEEDING:** The women will start 5 minutes after the men if number of entries exceed 100, otherwise the event will be swum as one heat
- AWARDS and RESULTS: 10K National Championships will receive USMS Championship Medals 1st to 6th place in all USMS recognized Age Groups (102.3.1). All-American patches will be awarded to the eligible first place finisher in each age group. Results will be by age group and gender and will be posted at http://www.ClemsonAquaticTeam.org

- **WATER CONDITIONS:** Hartwell is a calm freshwater lake; water temperature expected to be in the low 80s.
- LOCATION and DIRECTIONS: The event takes place at East Beach on the Clemson University campus. Directions: Coming from the North and East on I-85, take Exit 19B, go right on 76/28 to Clemson; from the South and West on Interstate 85, take Exit 14, go left on Highway 187, then left on 76/28 to Clemson. Take Highway 93 exit, turn left onto 93. * Pass the ESSO Club on right, take next left at light onto Perimeter Road, then an immediate right on to East Beach Drive at Clemson Rowing sign. Beach is at the end of the road.

From Hotels or Highway 123: Turn onto College Avenue (Highway 133) toward Clemson University. At the campus turn right onto Highway 93. Follow from * above.
