
2011 USMS 5K OPEN WATER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT

Hosted by: Coney Island Brighton Beach Open Water Swimmers, Inc. (CIBBOWS).

Location: Coney Island & Brighton Beaches. Event hosted at NY Aquarium, Surf Avenue & 8th Street, Brooklyn, NY 11224.

Facility: Race headquarters will be located on the second floor of Glover's Reef inside the New York Aquarium facility.

Restroom facilities are located on the lower levels of the Sea Cliffs exhibit and Glover's Reef. There are no locker room, changing room or shower facilities. Check-in and awards will be on the terrace of Glover's Reef. Entrants

and their families will have complete access to all New York Aquarium exhibits after the race.

Parking: Registered entrants may park at the New York Aquarium parking facility. For GPS purposes, use following address:

Eligibility: Open to all 2011 USMS-registered swimmers and FINA masters swimmers age 18 & older. A legible copy of your

2011 USMS registration card (or FINA equivalent) must be included with entry form. Age determination date for this

event is August 6, 2011. One event ("OEVT") registration/participation is NOT permitted in USMS National

Course: The race course is a 2.5K loop between Coney Island Pier and the end of Brighton Beach. Start/finish will be on the

beach in front of the New York Aquarium. Swim course will be clearly marked with buoys. Waves and swim direction will be determined closer to race date subject to number of race entrants and weather conditions. Expected water temperature range is 68-73 F, with some chop due to wind, and the possibility of flotsam, jetsam and jellyfish.

Rules: Wet suits are NOT permitted. Support craft other than designated race craft are not

permitted. All applicable 2011 USMS rules, regulations and safety requirements will be enforced. All suits and equipment must conform to current USMS open water rules.*

*In September 2010, the USMS House of Delegates voted to follow new regulations regarding swim suits for open water competition, **effective January 1, 2011.** For all open water national championship events, swimwear shall be made of textile material. For men, the swim suit shall not extend above the navel or below the knee. For women, the swim suit shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulders nor extend below the knees. There are no "fastener" specifications.



Timing: Electronic CHAMPIONCHIP TIMING will be used. Each swimmer will wear an electronic timing chip on an ankle

bracelet to automatically record their time. Timing chips will be collected at the finish area. Swimmers who fail to

return their chip will be assessed a \$30 charge.

Safety:

Lifeguards, jet skis and kayaks will monitor the entire course. There will also be a safety boat (possibly New York Harbor Police and Coast Guard) to keep other boats away. EMT personnel will be on-site. Any emergencies will be taken to Coney Island Hospital which is located three (3) miles from race headquarters. In case of inclement weather or dangerous conditions, the race director may close the course and prevent swimmers from completing the swim. Swimmers will be given a highly visible numbered swim cap that must be worn as the top cap during the swim. All swimmers must have their race number on their arm. Because of mass wave start, it is recommended that swimmers check their finger nails and toe nails for length. If nails are too long, they must be clipped to a reasonable length at the discretion of the official/referee.

Time Limit:

There is a 3 hour maximum time limit from race start time. Those not finished within time limit will be asked to exit the water and scored as "DNF" (Did Not Finish).

Age Groups: 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, and so on in five-year increments, as high as necessary for men and women.

Awards:

USMS National Championship medals will be awarded to the top ten (10) finishers by gender and age group. National Championship patches will be presented to the top finisher by gender in each age group. Foreign swimmers are not eligible for USMS All-American awards. Special prizes will be awarded to overall male and female finishers. Awards will be presented on the terrace of Glover's Reef approximately 20 minutes after the last swimmer has exited the water.

Schedule: 5:45AM: Check-in opens

6:50AM: Final briefing by course start

7:00AM: Race begins; wave start(s) at Event Director's discretion depending on number of entrants

10:00AM: Race course closes 10:20AM: Awards ceremony
