Official Interpretation Issued by the USMS Rules Committee Event Limits in USMS and USA Swimming Meets

Rule 102.6 says that a swimmer may compete in not more than six individual events per day when events are conducted in a timed finals format.

When competing in a USMS sanctioned meet, the daily event limit is determined by considering all events, <u>conforming and non-conforming</u>, swum at any <u>USMS sanctioned</u> meet on the same day. Events swum at USA Swimming sanctioned meets or at other recognized meets do <u>not</u> count towards the daily limit.
