## **LMSC Highlights**

- Allegheny Mountain
  - Membership increase to 524, 3 meets, sending two people to Relay, and two delegates to the Annual Meeting, planned for a budget deficit this year, partnering with their local YMCA, leadership team did a charity swim to raise \$10,000 for Cancer Bridges
- Illinois
  - Membership down, awards and swim meets went well, reasonably functioning LMSC, Big Shoulders on September 6.

- Indiana
  - Update provided in writing for Annual Meeting
- Kentucky
  - 472 members, slight decrease, 57 unattached members, 3 meets, Grown Up Swimming in Lexington, Central ALTS still operating
- Lake Erie
  - Hosted Tri-State Meet and State Championship, Brogan Water Swim
- Michigan
  - Membership down slightly, 19 teams and workout groups, trying to connect unattached swimmers to a team, added swimmer spotlights, worked on officiating and refereeing, hosted a state championship, new logo colors, had to initiate an MBR, adding a new meet at Oakland, hosting a stroke clinic with Cody Miller
- Ohio
  - 80 members below last year (810), Grown Up Swimming launch in Cincinnati, hosted three meets, no long course meets, planning the state championship for 2026, planning a duel sanctioned meet in Athens
- Wisconsin
  - Membership has stabilized, spent money to assist meet hosts, 8 SCY meets, 1 SCM meet, 1 fitness event, 1 virtual event, 1 LCM meet, sending newsletter, having a hard time getting new board members.
