Bob's proposal is as follows: Noncompetitive swims are those which swimmer placement is not included in results. (If there is a placement involved, that is a competitive event.) Trying to open events to USMS members those who would like to participate (maybe outside the current rules for no "toys", etc.) but not have their times published. The committee is asked to consider how to include these swimmers into the events.
