#### **Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 8:03pm EDT.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions of committee.
- 2. Reports from the chair (Phyllis), vice chair (Catherine), vice president (Robin), and NO representative (Jay).
  - Phyllis- We will review the OWNC events that have been held this year. We are working
    on the OWNC events for 2024. We have a presentation on this later this evening. The
    two national awards from our committee will be announced on Friday evening of the
    USMS annual meeting. There are still two OWNC events to be held. Mission Viejo 1 mile
    and 5k will be held on September 16,17. The registration is still open until September 10.
    The 5/10K virtual event is still open until September 15.
  - Catherine- The committee is working with the National Office to increase participation in the OWNC. The items we are discussing is a festival format that includes multiple events, easy airport access to events and having a OWNC event associated with a national pool championship. We are monitoring the use of technology at open water events, the patch for participation in the virtual events will require swimming all five events in 2023. I was liaison for the Cable swim the Middle distance OWNC events. Both events were well run, and the swimmers enjoyed the events.
  - Robin- Thank you to the committee for all the work done in 2023.
  - Jay- The national office is looking at ways to increase participation in virtual and open water events. This year the one-hour swim had over 1000 entries. The 5/10 event is still open and the 3/6k events start September 15. The grant program to help new events with funding is still available. There have been 43 Open water events sanctioned in 2023.
- 3. LDC annual meeting presentation- Jill Wright narrated this presentation that reviewed the OWNC for 2023 and previewed the events for 2024.

4. Questions for the audience. The rotation of the OWNC events across the country was discussed. The committee welcomes all bids for these events. Priority will be given for events "in area", but other bids will be considered if no other bids are received.

#### **New Business**

Jill and Phyllis will be presenting workshops at the USMS Relay meeting. Jill's presentation will discuss how to start an open water event. Phyllis's presentation will discuss the sanctioning process for open water events.

#### Tasks for the Upcoming Year

1. The two-mile cable swim at Foster Lake will be considered for 2024 when all the permits are completed, and the course is constructed.


