# Working With Your Club Board of Directors



## New teams or teams in early stages of start up – building a Board of Directors

- Develop a mission and vision
- Access yourself strengths and weaknesses; compliment that
- Think about term limits
- Tap certain skills that you think you'll need (attorney, accountant, fundraising, marketing, etc)
- Think about having an Executive Board within the Board (Pres, VP, Secretary, Treasurer)
- Consider having Team Captains (men's/women's) to aid in communication with team
- Keep your board involved with projects
- Create bylaws; two examples WCM and DAM

- Include a grievance policy; consider a code of conduct
- Consider becoming a 501c3





## <u>Established boards – keeping it fresh, inspiring growth</u>

- Review the mission and vision
- How can you advance the mission?
- Develop a code of conduct
- Keep your board size manageable
- Be award that board members are volunteers, keep turnover to avoid burnout
- Watch out for personal agendas of board members
- Define board purpose give them jobs
- Board should guide coaches, offer support
- Board should assist with staff development

# Working With Your Club Board of Directors



## DAM mission statement

Davis Aquatic Masters (DAM) is dedicated to providing a team environment that fosters physical fitness through swimming. Members are trained to gain the benefits of swimming, either competitively or for fitness, and are encouraged to compete in swim events, and to participate in civic events that benefit our community.

## Pacific Masters Mission statement:

The purpose of Pacific Masters Swimming is to encourage and promote physical fitness and enjoyment of swimming for adults 18 years of age and over through a program that supports clubs, coaches, facilities, education, competition and social opportunities.

## LMSC Coaches Chair



- Role Description
  - The Coaches Chair role will provide support to local clubs, workout groups and coaches through outreach and mentoring. They will identify opportunities to invest LMSC resources facilitating the growth and retention of clubs, workout groups, coaches and members.

# LMSC Coaches Chair – Duties & Responsibilities



- Create and maintain relationships with all clubs and coaches in the LMSC and act as point of contact to support clubs and coaches.
- Act as a liaison with new coaches and new clubs/workout groups.
- Support the ongoing education and development of new and current coaches within the LMSC.
- Communicate relevant and timely information from USMS and the Coaches Committee to clubs and coaches.
- Promote Gold Club designation and 100% USMS Membership of all swimmers in clubs and workout groups.
- Encourage participation in current USMS initiatives and events (e.g. Fitness Series events, Try Masters Swimming Month, etc.) and facilitate support from the LMSC. Encourage and provide assistance to clubs hosting events.
- Serve as an ambassador of USMS and the LMSC to support the growth of, and opportunities for, adult swimming.
- Act as a resource to clubs seeking coaches
- Work with the Club and Coach Development staff at the National Office as needed.
