## MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 8:05AM by Brandon Franklin.

- Brandon opened the meeting with a presentation/overview of SSLF for trustees and attendees. This included the SSLF purpose, statistics that support the cause of SSLF, recap of Adult Learn-to-Swim month including a media recap, proclamation update, resources USMS is providing, and criteria for grant consideration.
