Directions: Approaching from the north or south on I-81, get off at exit 18 (Adams & Harrison Sts) and turn east (uphill) on E Adams St. Take the first right turn (at the crest of the hill) onto Irving Ave. Go straight ahead several blocks, past hospitals and Carrier Dome to its end. Straight on is the entrance to SUNY Environmental campus. Follow Forestry Drive around to the left, beside the south side of the Dome (on your left), continue up the hill, turn left at the top of the hill past Archbold Gym on your left, follow road to the right, and look on your left side for an orange sign for **Q-3 parking lot** shortly after you bear right.

From the east on I-690 exit at Townsend, turn left (south) to E Adams, proceed as above.

From the west on I-690 exit south onto I-81, proceed as above.

Parking: Swimmers can use the Carnegie parking lot (the lot close to the pool) and the Q-3 and Q-4 lots for overflow parking. **No parking in SUNY Environmental Forestry School lots!**
