WAIVER

I understand that swimming across the Straits of Mackinac in the Mighty Mac Swim, or assisting any of the swimmers in the Mighty Mac Swim, whether volunteering or paid, are potentially hazardous activities that may expose me or others to serious, permanent injury or death, and I should not participate in this event in any capacity unless I am medically able and properly trained. If a swimmer, I certify that the information contained on my Mighty Mac Swim pre-qualification form was submitted by me and accurately represents my swimming experience, current swimming ability and state of my current health to the best of my knowledge. I understand that I may be required to produce a doctor's slip to participate in this event. I assume all risks associated with my participation in this event including, but not limited to any personal injuries, or damage to my property, I am aware of the possibility of objects falling from the Mackinac Bridge, all such risks being known and appreciated by me, and I waive any claim that I might otherwise have against any person or organization described in this paragraph arising out of my participation including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions. I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, hereby agree to defend and hold harmless the State of Michigan (including but not limited to the Governor's office. Mackinac Bridge Authority, Michigan Department of Transportation, Mackinac State Historic Parks, Department of Natural Resources, Pure Michigan and the Michigan Fitness Foundation), the City of St. Ignace, the Village of Mackinaw City, Habitat for Humanity of Michigan and their affiliates, Event Marketing Enterprises, Pfeiffer Lincoln, Walstrom Marine, Arnold Mackinac Island Ferry, Aquaman, FINIS, all event and athlete sponsors, support boat and personal watercraft owners, boat crew (henceforth including Captains, vessel operators, First Mates, deck hands, lifeguards and volunteer spotters), suppliers, vendors, hosts, staff and volunteers for the *Mighty Mac Swim* and it's ancillary events, along with their respective departments, boards, agencies, commissions, directors, officers, agents, employees, successors and assigns, from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of my participation in this event. If a watercraft owner, I agree to defend and hold harmless the aforementioned for any acts of negligence on behalf of myself, my crew, or any passenger on my vessel, and I warrant that I carry primary liability insurance to cover my vessel. All vessel operators, crew, or passengers aboard any event support vessel will wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device at all times, or carry a life-saving flotation device if a lifeguard. If I am serving as a lifeguard, I warrant that I will be certified on the date of any event for which I am serving. I grant permission to all of the foregoing to broadcast or use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of my participation in this event for any legitimate purpose. All swimmers, event staff, volunteers, lifeguards, boat and personal watercraft crew (including crew performing under the authority of boat owners), agree to withhold from drinking alcoholic beverages during the Mighty Mac swim and within 24 hours before said event. All Event personnel and swimmers understand that the Mighty Mac Swim may be cancelled due to acts of God, terrorism or any other circumstance beyond the control of Event Owner or Organizers, without refunds granted. If a swimmer, I understand that if I am disgualified from participating in the *Mighty Mac Swim* for not meeting my quarterly \$700 minimum fundraising requirement by the deadline dates (all such dates known by me), or if I fail to meet my overall fundraising minimum of \$3,000, any funds that I have raised or contributed in the name of charity are nonrefundable and are nontransferable to another swimmer. If I am late in meeting a fundraising deadline, I understand that I may be reinstated in the Mighty Mac Swim, if I pay a \$200 penalty

within 48 hours to remain eligible. Furthermore, I understand that there may need to be a minimum amount of revenue generated by Mighty Mac Swim participants to cover Event expenses. If the expected number of participants do not register, and there is a shortfall in revenue as a result, event features may be scaled down accordingly, without sacrificing safety. I recognize that every attempt will be made to still hold the event if a shortfall in revenue, due to a lack of participants, occur. However, if event and/or government authorities determine that the shortfall is adversely affecting safety, the Mighty Mac Swim may be cancelled and any monies already paid will benefit Habitat for Humanity of Michigan, and will not be refunded. I recognize that in the unlikely occurrence of the Mighty Mac Swim Event Director experiencing sudden death or mental incapacitation, the event may be cancelled, although every attempt will be made to fill the responsibilities of the Event Director. I understand that all monies paid to Habitat for Humanity of Michigan will not be refunded, in such a circumstance. I warrant that I am of legal age (18 years or older) and that I have read and fully understand the foregoing terms, and by signing my name below. I agree to abide by all and any of the rules for this event, written or verbal as mandated by event authorities. Furthermore, watercraft owners agree to abide by the requirements for participation in this event as stipulated by the U.S. Coast Guard, the Department of Natural Resources and any other applicable authority. By signing below, all participating non-swimmers (all those serving under the direction of Event Marketing Enterprises, inc.), consent to a criminal background check.

Alternates may have the opportunity to recruit sponsors and/or raise funds to swim in the place of an athlete who drops out voluntarily or does not meet a deadline for a minimum fundraising requirement.

All fundraising monies in a swimmer's possession must be turned in prior to the final fundraising milestone deadline.
