The 37th Annual Tennessee Senior Olympics is a sports competition for athletes 50 and older that combines a wide range of competitive activities. Residents from 10 District/Metropolitan areas across the state will be competing. The mission of the Senior Olympics is to promote healthy lifestyles for seniors through fitness, sports, and an active involvement in life.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Athletes who have participated in a 2016 or winter 2017 Tennessee Senior Olympics district event.
- Athletes may only enter those exact sports or events that were played at the district. Exception: Doubles sports may enter all three (singles, doubles, and mixed) if one of these events was played at district.
- **OPEN SPORTS exceptions:**

The following sports do not require district participation in order to register for the state finals.

Archery, Cycling (5K/20K), Power Walk Racquetball, Road Races (5K/10K), Pole Vault Triple Jump

Any sport not offered at your district. Golf: District Golfers will be given first chance to register and then golf will be opened.
